A WORD FROM THE MAYOR



Happy August, Westover. I'm sure everyone is looking forward to the hustle and bustle of the school year starting. It certainly is a busy time of year, getting back into fall and out of the lazy summertime.

Your City Staff has been busy preparing for our new Fiscal year, which begins October 1st, by reviewing the pros and cons of this past year and what we might be able to do to improve conditions during the upcoming year. We are very pleased with the addition of a full time Deputy in our City, who has now been on duty almost of year. The Deputy has made an impact in the community by his presence on US 280, as well as putting a watchful eye on some troubled locations and street corners. We believe that crime has been reduced and prevented, as some of the "hangout" locations are no longer in operation. I hope you all have noticed that and that you will thank our Deputy when you have an opportunity to do so.

Our Planning Commission continues their work on revamping the land use plan for the US 280 corridor, which includes a new traffic management study, which will need to be approved by the Alabama Department of Transportation. As businesses come to Westover, along US 280, we need to have a plan in place to manage the increasing traffic along the corridor. The Commission meets on the 4th Tuesday of each month and is using special called work sessions as needed, to prepare their plan for you, the public to review. These meetings are always open to the Public for comment. I believe everyone will agree that the traffic nightmare on the West side of the mountain doesn't need to continue through Westover.

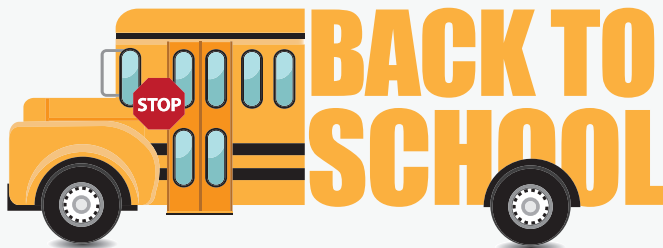

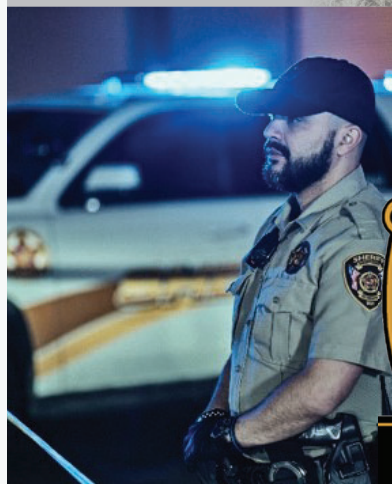
