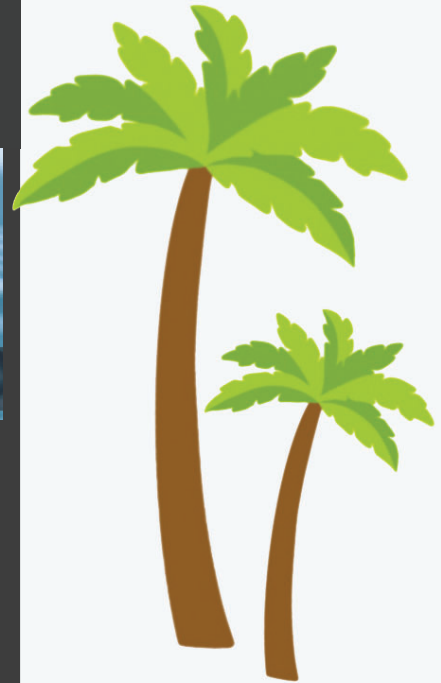

BEST SALSA RECIPE

YIELDS: 1 quart

Ingredients

4 green onions

1/2 bunch fresh cilantro

3 medium vine-ripe red tomatoes

1/4 cup red wine vinegar

2 jalapenos, seeded

6 ounces tomato juice

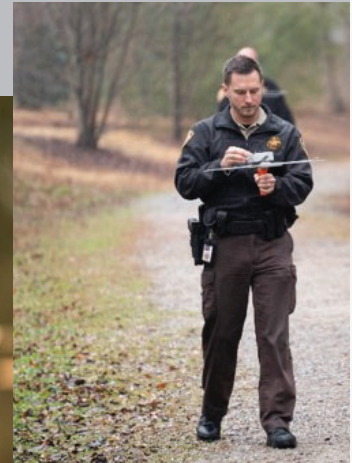
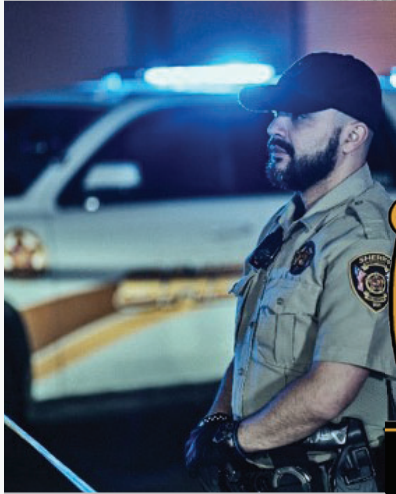
1 medium green pepper

Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

1/4 cup diced red onion

Dice the green onions, tomatoes, jalapenos and green peppers and blend together. Add the red onions. Mince the cilantro and add to the vegetables. Add the vinegar and finish with the tomato juice. Season with salt and pepper. Chill before serving.
